

ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION
For use by Domestic Nonprofit Corporations

Pursuant to the provisions of Act 162, Public Acts of 1982, the undersigned corporation executes the following Articles:

ARTICLE I

The name of the corporation is:

ARTICLE II

The purpose or purposes for which the corporation is formed are:

To establish a ministry where everyone can learn and live more fully into the joy of being a Christian. Through both traditional camp ministries and other new endeavors, we will facilitate spiritual growth, environmental stewardship, human development and service to our neighbors.

This corporation is organized exclusively for religious, charitable, recreation, educational and scientific purposes, including, for such purposes, the making of distributions to organizations that qualify as exempt organizations under section 501 (c) (3) of the Internal Revenue Code or the corresponding section of any future federal tax code.

ARTICLE III

Article 6. Non-Discrimination Policy

This corporation shall not discriminate against any individual(s) for reasons of race, color, creed, disability, ethnicity, hearing status, national origin, race, religion, sex, or sexual orientation.

Article 7. Dissolution and Disposition of Corporate Assets

Upon the dissolution of the corporation, the Board of Directors shall, after paying or making provision for payment of all of the liabilities of the corporation, dispose of all of the assets of the corporation exclusively for the purposes of the corporation, to the Presbyterian Church (USA) under the trusteeship of the Presbytery of Lake Michigan to be used for the purpose of camp scholarships and / or the financial support of Presbyterian Camps or their programs and personnel. Should the Presbyterian Church (USA) no longer qualify as an exempt organization under Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986 (or the corresponding provision of any future United States Internal Revenue Law), the Board of Directors shall dispose of all of the assets of the corporation to an organization or organizations exclusively for charitable, recreational, educational, religious or scientific purposes that shall at the time qualify as an exempt organization or organizations under Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986 (or the corresponding provision of any future United States Internal Revenue Law), as the Board of Directors shall determine. Any of such assets not so disposed of shall be disposed of by the Circuit Court of Kent County, Michigan, if the principal office of the corporation is located in the said county at the time of dissolution of the said corporation, or by the Circuit Court (or equivalent thereof) of the county in which the principal office of the corporation is then located, exclusively, for such purposes or to such organization or organizations, as the said Court shall determine, which are organized and operated exclusively for such purposes.

Article 8. Statement of Purpose Prohibitions

(i) No part of the net earnings of the corporation shall inure to the benefit of, or be distributable to, its members, trustees, officers, or other persons, except that the corporation shall be authorized and empowered to pay reasonable compensation for services rendered to the corporation and to make payments and distributions in furtherance of the purposes set forth herein; (ii) No substantial part of the activities of the corporation shall be the carrying on of propaganda, or otherwise attempting to influence legislation, and the corporation shall not participate in, or intervene in (including the publishing or distribution of statements) any political campaign on behalf of any candidate for public office except as authorized under the Internal Revenue Code of 1954, as amended; (iii) The corporation shall not carry on any other activities not permitted to be carried on (a) by a corporation exempt from Federal income tax under 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1954, as amended (or the corresponding provision of any future United States Internal Revenue law).

Article 9. Per motion at the organizational meeting of Greenwood Ministries Association on June 19th, 2016, it was resolved that Rev. Karen Fitz La Barge is authorized to sign these articles of incorporation, all other official documents on behalf of the incorporators. (See Attached)
